Het registreren gebeurt als volgt:


Step 1


Short Course Description:

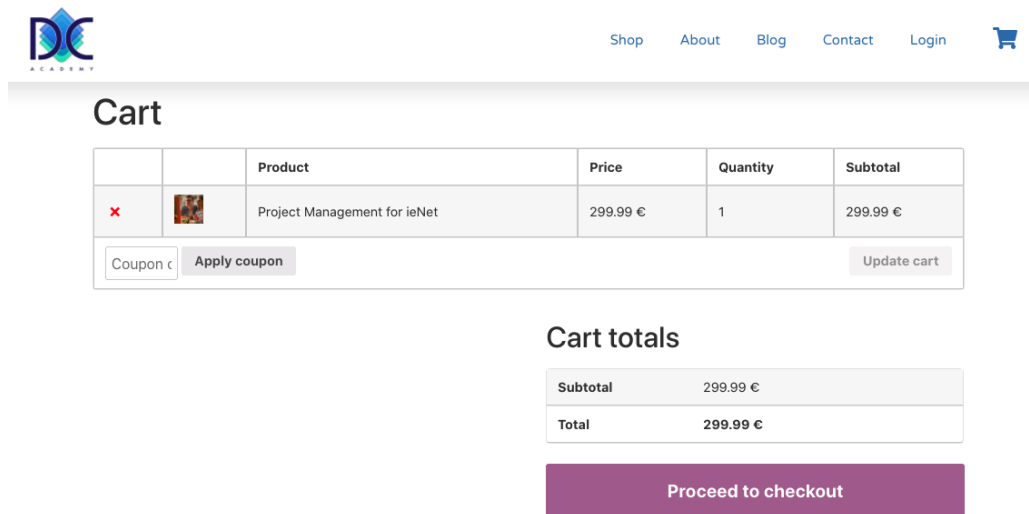
Stap 4

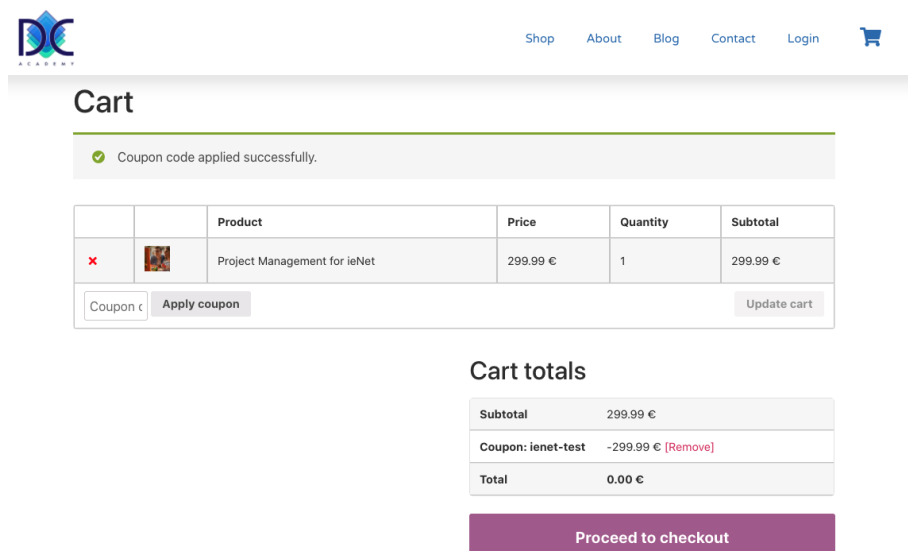


Stap 5

In Project Management Tools and Techniques, both waterfall, agile and kanban are discussed and compared. You will understand how to apply these principles in your projects to increase success. The tools and techniques presented in the course can be used in waterfall and agile environments. After completing the course, you will have reviewed more than 80% of the tools and techniques that are described in the PMBOK, sixth edition.
